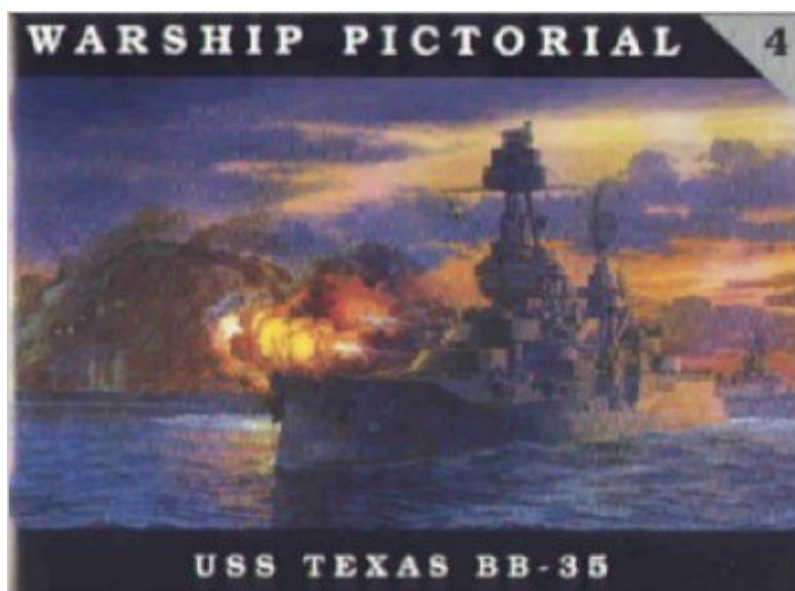

The WARSHIP PICTORIAL books have always been good value for the money. They combine brief ship histories with a wealth of b&w and color photographs and artwork to give the reader good primers on a variety of warships. Steve Wiper and Tom Flowers' USS TEXAS BB-35, which was published by Classic Warships Publishing in 2006, is a good example of the high-quality found in series titles. Fifty-six pages long, the book starts off with a three-page chronological summary of BB-35's career and then presents page after page of well-reproduced, well-captioned photographs of USS Texas from 1913 to 1989. Many of the pix are full-page; four are in color. Also included are numerous cutaways and diagrams of BB-35 armament along with top-notch color side and overview profiles of the ship at various stages in its career. Two pages of general specs, references, etc. close out the book. One point in passing: when comparing the two overhead profiles of BB-35 in 1914 and 1945, it's incredible to see the stupendous increase in anti-aircraft weaponry. In any case, USS TEXAS BB-35 is a nice, appealingly-illustrated primer to this legendary battleship. Recommended. \*\*\*\*\*7,350 Helpful Votes!
